FL150 SPRAY BUFF MAINTAINER & RESTORER

DESCRIPTION: **SPRAY BUFF** is a ready-to-use product designed to maintain and restore polished floors without damage to the finish film. This product contains mild surfactants, detergents, and solvents that will clean and polish without excessive floor finish powder. **SPRAY BUFF** remove dirt, black marks, and scuffs and renew the gloss to its original luster.

RECOMMENDED USES: **SPRAY BUFF** should be used in the traffic lanes and heavy wear areas of wax floors to restore and improve appearance. **SPRAY BUFF** prolongs the life of a floor finish and greatly extends the time between strippings and recoatings. Can be used on vinyl asbestos, asphalt, vinyl tiles, terrazzo, Mexican tile, quarry tile, or any floor that usually is waxed. **SPRAY BUFF** is a great time saver.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Sweep and/or damp mop the floor area to be treated. Spray a light amount of **SPRAY BUFF** on the washable area of the floor. Place a red or gold pad under the machine and buff the dampened area until dry and bright. Continue procedures until the total area is buffed. When pads load up with dirt, use the reverse side of the pad. When finished, wash the pads for future use. Dust mop the floor to remove any residue from buffing.

For high-speed buffers: Mix 1 part product to 1 part water into a mop bucket. Wring out the mop and damp mop the floor. High-speed or buff the floor with red or gold pads until dry and bright. After cleaning with red or gold pads, high-speed or buff your floor with the white pad for the ultimate gloss.
