DESCRIPTION: **EMULSION BOWL CLEANER** is a concentrated bowl cleaner with a balanced, effective combination of Hydrochloric Acid and wetting agent. This product will dissolve such deposits as lime, scale, and rust from the surface of toilet bowls and urinals. The wetting agents help to penetrate the soil so that the acid can more easily dissolve and remove stains and scale.

- Removes rust
- Deodorizes urinals and toilet bowls
- Dissolves lime and scale
- Once-over surface cleaning for average soil

USES: **EMULSION BOWL CLEANER** is formulated for use in toilet bowls and urinals only. NOT FOR USE in showers, sinks, and tubs. For use in schools, offices, hospitals, motels, and restaurants.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

TOILET BOWLS: Shake well before use. Remove water from bowl. Pour 2-4 ounces of product on swab mop, holding swab mop over bowl. Clean bowl under rim and water outlet holes. Allow **EMULSION BOWL CLEANER** to work until all rust, scale, and deposits are loosened. Rinse by flushing. Preliminary cleaning is required for heavily soiled areas.

URINALS: Remove screens or strainers. Pour 2-5 ounces on swab mop, holding swab mop over urinal. Clean all surfaces, edges, and water outlet holes. Allow **EMULSION BOWL CLEANER** to work until all rust, scale, and deposits are loosened. Flush to rinse. Replace screen
